## **Memorial – Media Reminder**

January 12, 2011

This is a reminder regarding the presence of media at the events occurring throughout Pima County. The families have requested that media not contact them at this difficult time. The families have asked that media respect that they are mourning their loved ones, and treat the events with the reverence they deserve. There is also concern about media causing a disruption with friends and loved ones attending services.

St. Adillia, St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. Thomas have requested that the media not violate the boundaries of their private property. While media is allowed on the premises, please do not attempt to sneak recording devices inside the services. Anybody found trying to violate these restrictions will be asked to leave immediately.

St. Odillia's will not allow any media on the church property. A staging area for the media will be set up at the northwest corner of Chapala and Paseo Del Norte. No recording devices of any kind will be allowed inside the church.

St. Elizabeth Ann Seton will not allow any media on the church property. A staging area will be provided west of the church on Shannon Road. A pool camera will be available through CNN; please contact them for further information. No recording devices of any kind will be allowed inside the church.

St. Thomas will not allow any media on the church property. A staging area will be announced at a later date. No recording devices of any kind will be allowed inside the church.

The burial at Holy Hope Cemetery will be private, not open to the public or members of the media.

Please remember that members of the media are expected to adhere to all applicable Arizona State Laws and county or city ordinances. Members of the media are requested to stay within the boundaries of the media staging areas, so they do not cause an interference with the services or people attending them.
